DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Shake well before using. Test on all surfaces in an inconspicuous area before using. If surface discolors, fades or fiber color transfers to a white cloth, do not use.

FOR CARPET, UPHOLSTERY, CLOTHING & FABRIC:

1. Spray Ink Remover on a clean towel, and blot the problem area. Do not rub.
2. Continue lightly blotting the ink stain from the fiber. After a few blots, reapply the Ink Remover to another section of the clean towel, and continue to blot. The ink will transfer to the towel.
3. Repeat until the spot is gone.

FOR STUBBORN INK STAINS:

1. Spray Ink Remover on a clean towel, and blot the problem area. Do not rub.
2. Continue lightly blotting the ink stain from the fiber. After a few blots, spray the Ink Remover on the fiber and place a clean, multi folded towel over spot to blot (May use paper towels but use several and fold.) . The ink will transfer to the towel.
3. Apply constant pressure to the towel by placing a heavy weight on the towel. (The weight will help wick all residue from the fiber to the towel.)
4. Let stand for 15-30 minutes. If stain remains repeat procedure until ink is totally removed.

FOR WALLS, FLOOR AND TILE:

1. Spray stain thoroughly, wait one minute.
2. Wipe with clean cloth or rinse off. Repeat if necessary.
